## Château des Moines Prestige Lalande de Pomerol

**Grape Variety** 

10%

Cabernet

Merlot,

Sauvignon, 10% Cabernet Franc



The soil is composed of dry gravel and the subsoil is clay-limestonegravelly with traces of iron oxide called 'iron dirt'.
1.5 ha
The vineyard is cultivated in a traditional way with parcel management: soil plowing, grassing, diversity Mechanical leaf removal and green harvesting. A selection of plots is made, favoring old vines.
Destemming and crushing of the harvest, followed by cold maceration for five days in order to extract a maximum of aromas. Alcoholic and malolactic fermentations are carried out in tanks with temperature control. The duration of high-temperature maceration and final hot maceration lasts between 18 to 30 days depending on the tank to obtain a maximum of concentration and balance.
The wine is aged in new oak barrels for 18 months and bottled on the property.

## Tasting notes



Vintage 2022: Presents a deep and intense robe with seductive garnet reflections. On the nose, rich aromas of black fruits, such as black cherry and blackberry, harmoniously intertwine with subtle notes of vanilla and toasted oak. On the palate, the structure is elegant, well-integrated tannins offer a silky texture, followed by a slight acidity bringing a very pleasant finish to the wine. A promising wine that should evolve gracefully over the years. This Cuvée will pair perfectly with a perfectly cooked tournedos Rossini.

To be consumed within 10 years.

Vintage 2020: This wine with an intense garnet robe, offers a rich and opulent fruit on the nose, enhanced by fine roasted and spicy notes.

In the mouth, a velvety texture of well-concentrated black fruits unfolds, subtly toasted, lightly vanilla-flavored, and enhanced by elegant tannins.

Nice balance of flavors for this wine. The finish is long, with a beautiful aromatic persistence and excellent aging potential.

Vintage 2019: This elegant wine with a dark and brilliant garnet robe offers us a dense nose of black fruits, with integrated woody notes. The palate is full, fleshy, fruity (morello cherry), supported by well-rounded tannins. This cuvée reveals a generous and concentrated material, delicately toasted, unveiling a structure that gives it character.

The finish is long, fresh, and velvety. This vintage, with its expressive aromatic palette, offers excellent aging potential.

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
